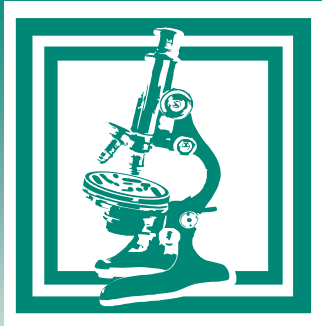

Use this product in: day care centers, nursing homes, institutional facilities, public rest rooms, schools, health care facilities, colleges, shower and bath areas, locker rooms, prisons and cars. Use this product on washable hard, nonporous surfaces of: countertops, floors, bathroom fixtures, tables (non-wooden picnic tables), outdoor furniture except cushions and wood frames, chairs, desks, telephones, walls, cabinets, doorknobs, shower stalls (Fiberglass), tubs (Fiberglass), toilets, bathroom and kitchen sinks (Fiberglass), and other hard nonporous surfaces made of: metal, stainless steel, glazed porcelain, glazed ceramic, sealed stone and plastic. This product is a Hospital Disinfectant for pre-cleaned surfaces at 5 ounces per gallon. This product is specially formulated to effectively eliminate offensive odors caused by mold and mildew.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE - Preparation of use-solution:** Add 5 oz. per gallon of water, to disinfect hard, pre-cleaned nonporous surfaces.

**DISINFECTION/VIRUCIDAL DIRECTIONS:** Remove gross filth or heavy soil, then thoroughly clean surfaces. Apply use-solution to hard nonporous surfaces, thoroughly wetting surfaces with a cloth, mop, sponge, or sprayer. For sprayer applications, use a coarse spray device. Spray 6-8 inches from surface, rub with brush, sponge or cloth. Avoid breathing spray. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe dry with a clean cloth or sponge or let air dry. Rinse all surfaces that come in contact with food such as countertops, appliances, tables and stovetops with potable water before reuse. Do not use on utensils, glassware or dishes. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if the use-solution becomes visibly diluted or soiled. This product is not for use on medical device surfaces.

**To Clean and Deodorize or to Pre-clean Prior to Disinfection:** Depending on the soil level of the area to be cleaned, use 12 - 16 oz. of this product per gallon of water. Rub with brush, sponge or cloth. Wipe dry with a clean cloth or sponge or let air dry. **For Mildew Control:** Follow directions for Disinfection. Repeat treatment every seven days or when new growth appears. **Deodorizing directions: For Odors Caused by Flooding and Smoke:** Use 32 oz. of this product per gallon of water. Follow directions for "To Clean and Deodorize". **For Odors Caused by Dogs, Cats and Other Domestic Animals:** Use on rugs, floors, walls, tile, cages, crates, mats, floor coverings, or any surface soiled by a pet. Test a small inconspicuous area first. Blot problem area. Then follow directions for "To Clean and Deodorize" or "Pet Odors" as appropriate. **Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Hotels, Schools, Restaurants:** 2 - 4 ounces in chemical toilets, waste receptacles, bed pans, drainage bottles, diaper pails, hampers, disposals, commodes and air conditioner pans will eliminate odors.
