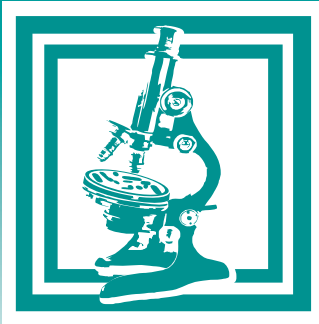

This product is effective against a wide variety of gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria. It is also an excellent deodorant and is especially effective in controlling odors that are bacterial in origin. This product mixes with water to form clear, stable use solutions. Use solutions are non-corrosive and non-staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals. Has a pleasant pine odor. This product may be used for cleaning and deodorizing, one step cleaning, and disinfection, or disinfection of precleaned, non-porous, inanimate hard surfaces.

CLEANING: TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE OR TO PRECLEAN PRIOR TO DISINFECTION. Depending on the soil level of the area to be cleaned, use 3 to 12 oz. of this product per gallon of water.

FOR DEODORIZING GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES, AND GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT. It is especially important to preclean for the product to perform properly. Then, apply a wetting concentration of 16 oz. of this product per gallon of water.

DISINFECTING: HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, AND OTHER MEDICALLY RELATED USES: Use 7½ oz. of this product per gallon of water (1 part to 16 parts water) for one-step cleaning and disinfection of areas with light to medium soil loads. For heavily soiled areas, preclean as described above and then disinfect with this product at 6 oz. per gallon (1 part to 20 parts water)

SCHOOLS, INDUSTRIAL AREAS, BARBER SHOPS, RESTROOMS, RESTAURANTS, FOOD AND MEAT PROCESSING PLANTS (NON-FOOD PROCESSING AREAS), PUBLIC ROOMS, OTHER NON-MEDICAL USES: Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from area or carefully protected. After use, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. Preclean surfaces. Then, disinfect with a solution of 4 oz. of this product in a gallon of water (1 part to 31 parts water). Alternatively, clean and disinfect in one operation using 7½ oz. of this product per gallon of water.

FOR MILDEW CONTROL: Follow directions for hospital disinfection. Repeat treatment every seven days, or when new growth appears.
